Sermon Two: Why we don't share our faith

Suggested Ideas:

- We don't need all the answers to share Christ. Biblical people simply told others of how Christ had helped them... why don't we?
- We don't need to know everything about the faith. After all, you're a Christian and nobody explained every answer to you, right?

- Don't want to do it alone. Your church supports you, the Christian ministry EI4G supports you, other churches in the area support you, etc. This is a collective effort in which your story, no matter how simple or amazing, is unique and *extremely* powerful.
- Not our "job" to evangelize. Doesn't God call us to share through the Great Commission? He also mentions in 1 Peter 3:15 that we should give a reason for the hope that lives within us.
- <u>Story:</u> Imagine a group of firefighters polishing their fire engine outside a burning building. They are so consumed with what they are doing that they are oblivious to the cries of help from terrified people who are trapped at a top floor window. Obviously, there's nothing wrong with cleaning their fire engine, but not while people are trapped in a burning building! *It's the same with those that need to hear the Gospel. There is nothing wrong with studying the Bible, doing church activities and the like, but there are people out there that don't believe in Christ and their fate is worse than those trapped inside a burning building.*

Suggested Ideas:

- Most of us know the Gospel, but for it to sink in and to remind ourselves I encourage you to write down your story/your testimony.
- If you were to write a thank you card to God, what would it say?
- Most meaningful presentation of the Gospel is how it worked in your life.
- Your story is unique and God wants you to share it.
- What areas has God helped you be specific (drug abuse, marital troubles, financial difficulties, etc.).
- Facts tell, stories sell.

Sermon Four: Simple ways to share your faith
